By taking photos of other unusual plants you may notice today, we suggest you use a plant identification app on your phone to learn more about them. Hostesses and Master Gardeners are available to assist you during your visits.

THE SOUND OF MUSIC

Garden 1

PALM CITY STARTING POINT – This enchanting property is your starting point to exchange your ticket and/or get your wristband from the PayPal list. There may be tickets available using PayPal or checks, **no cash**, for patrons who did not pre-purchase tickets.

TOUR PARKING: Ample parking. Please follow instructions from Parking Attendants.



Stroll through a serene setting with archways, statues and crepe jasmine scenting the air. The host is graciously offering parking, handicap access, beverages, and bathrooms. This garden displays plants that you can replicate in your own garden, as they are readily available at local garden centers. Saunter through meandering paths that beckon you to explore every turn through this relaxing venue. Also enjoy the classic cars exhibited here.



1. Egyptian Star Flower, *Pentas lanceolata*.

Bright colored blooms that are colorful and easy to grow as either an annual or perennial. Good as pollinators. It symbolizes love, chastity, protection and freedom.

2. Crown of Thorns, *Euphorbia milii*. This plant has beautiful red, pink or yellow flowers with long thorns. Some are bred without thorns. It is thought that the species was introduced to the Middle East in ancient times from Madagascar. Associated with the crown-of-thorns worn by Jesus Christ upon His crucifixion.

3. Woodland Elaeocarpus, *Elaeocarpus sylvestris*. Tree that grows cylindrical-upright in a small footprint up to 49 feet. It is often crafted into religious garlands. It is easy to grow and has a pretty white flower. Sun loving.

4. Asiatic Jasmine, *Trachelospermum asiaticum*. The large, white showy flowers have a wonderful fragrance. This groundcover can spread quickly and helps with soil erosion. It is often used in Japanese gardens.

5. Slender Goldshower, *Galphimia gracilis*. Shrub with bright yellow flowers that is easy to grow, drought tolerant and a prolific bloomer.

6. Ti plant, *Cordyline fruticosa*. Vibrant pinks and purples make this a show-stopper in Florida gardens. Different varieties make this a fun and easy plant to grow. Ti plants have cultural significance in some Pacific Island traditions where they are associated with good luck and protection.



7. American Wisteria, *Wisteria frutescens*.

Beautiful, fragrant violet flowers which act as pollinators. This plant is from the United States and used by Native Americans. Memorable blooms in late Spring and Summer. Let's hope it is in bloom! It symbolizes love, longevity and immortality.

8. Orchids, *Orchidaceae*. There are many varieties of orchids growing in the trees. They are easy to grow and adapt well to Florida. Ask the Master Gardeners if you have questions about how to grow them in your trees.



TOUR PARKING: Ample parking. Please follow instructions from Parking Attendants.



This is an impressive compound! One owner collects classic cars, while his wife owns a successful commercial landscaping business. These gracious owners rarely open their estate to the public, but feel that The Garden Club of Stuart is a worthy cause. A circular driveway will display some of the getaway cars, including C1, C2 and C8 Corvettes ranging from 1959 to 2023, around a peaceful fountain with tall palms and other varieties of commercial landscaping. This sleek estate flows from the road to the river in Palm City. As you peruse the property, enjoy the music flowing from a unique truck that would be happy to roll down any parade route. There are also other undercover surprises awaiting you during your tour of this property! A raffle for two original watercolor paintings will be held here.



1. Royal Palm, *Roystonea regia*.

Majestic palm that can grow up to 100 feet. They are native to Florida and valued for their beauty and hurricane resistance.

2. Bird of Paradise, *Strelitzia reginae*.

A striking tropical plant with vibrant bird-like flowers and large banana-like leaves that thrives in warm climates. Research suggests that it has the potential to improve soil and reduce heavy metals.

3. Sabal Palm, *Sabal palmetto*.

A hardy, fan-leaved evergreen with a thick trunk that is native to the southeastern United States. Also known as the cabbage palm, it is tolerant to salt, drought, and cold. It is the state tree of both Florida and South Carolina.

4. Live Oak, *Quercus virginiana*.

A massive, long-lived (350 years) evergreen tree with sprawling branches draped in Spanish moss. They are high-wind resistant and adaptable to sandy or limestone soil. Considered a hallmark Florida tree.


Palma Siegle Original Watercolor Paintings

INDIANA JONES



STUART STARTING POINT – Starting across the street from either side of Martin County Sailfish Sands Restaurant & Bar, you will exchange your ticket and/or get your wristband from the PayPal list. There may be tickets available using PayPal or checks, **no cash**, for patrons who did not pre-purchase tickets.

TOUR PARKING: Parking is available on the far south or north side of Martin County Sailfish Sands public golf course. From there, you can easily walk to either Garden 3 or Garden 4 as they are about one city block from each other. Please avoid parking directly in front of Sailfish Sands Restaurant & Bar or the golf area. **Note:** You may use the restrooms at Sailfish Sands, and even stop in for a tasty quick bite and beverage.

The owner of this exceptional property is a commercial grower who admittedly says that if he sees something unusual, he has to have it! Expect a strategically designed jungle complete with stone idols, reflection ponds and secret



pathways. As you enter, the road will meander thru the property and you will be enveloped by the oversized vegetation. One might think you are in an Indiana Jones movie, so watch out for poisonous darts! The jungle and deep shade transition to an oasis bathed in sunlight facing the Indian River. Once thought to be extinct in 1965, the atala butterfly has made a comeback thanks to local Florida efforts, including this owner's part, in helping to bring them back to the area. Growing coonties, their sole host plant in the garden, will promote the population.





1. Golden Elephant Ear, *Alocasia macrorrhizos* 'Lutea.' Beautiful “Giant Taro” that has vivid chartreuse and yellow leaves. Jurassic Park size.



2. Cohune Palm, *Attalea cohune*. Large 80-foot palm with towering trunk and massive fronds. It produces seeds that yield nutritious oil known as cohune oil, which is utilized in cooking and soap production. Slow growing.

3. Philodendron 'Summer Glory.' Rare, stunning hybrid that displays huge broad leaves with a reddish stem.

4. Philodendron Billietiae. Heart-shaped, medium, wavy-ribbed leaves with orange-yellow stems that work well in groupings.

5. Chinese Evergreen, *Aglaonema* 'Wishes.' Striking red and green leaved low growing plant that is used as a ground cover in this garden.

6. Zebra Alopecia, *Alocasia zebrina*.

Gorgeous large, arrow-shaped leaves and distinctive striped stems. Reminds you that you should look over your shoulder for poisonous darts!

7. Marquesas Palm, *Pelagodoxa henryana*.

Beautiful palm with large, undivided leaves with a silver underside that is critically endangered from French Polynesia. It can grow up to 20 feet.

8. Gray Baby Tears, *Pilea glauca*. Gray-green, low-growing groundcover that creates a soothing mat.

9. Beaked Yucca, *Yucca rostrata* ‘Silver Select.’

Spiky fun yucca with a spherical crown of narrow blue-gray leaves atop a single trunk. Known as “the Queen of the Yuccas.” Located on the river side.

10. Dwarf Betel Nut Palm, *Areca catechu* ‘dwarf.’ Compact, single-trunk palm with emerald green foot-long leaves. Located on the river side.

11. Narrow-Leafed Bird of Paradise, *Strelitzia juncea*. Spiky narrow-leaf plant produces flowers resembling Bird of Paradise blooms. Located on the river side.





TOUR PARKING:

Parking is available on the far south or north side of the Martin County Sailfish Sands public golf course. From there, you can easily walk to either Garden 3 or Garden 4 as they are about one city block from each other. Please avoid parking directly in front of Sailfish Sands Restaurant & Bar or the golf area. **Note:** You may use the restrooms at Sailfish Sands, and even stop in for a tasty quick bite and beverage.

This whimsical estate is owned by a Master Gardener who loves a diverse variety of plants. Some of the trees were grown from seed, which is truly remarkable!

Stroll through this property and see many unusual specimens such as the Ylang-ylang which is used to produce Chanel No. 5, an ornamental silk floss tree, and a stunning rainbow eucalyptus. This gardener

loves quirky, and that adds to the fun of this garden. Be amazed by the sheer number of different plants, and be sure to visit the back side of the property which faces the Indian River. Please enjoy the classic cars, and look for our Silent Auction table in this garden.

Starting on the left side of driveway:

1. Rainbow Eucalyptus, *Eucalyptus deglupta*. A beautiful, fast-growing tree known for its bark color. Can grow as tall as 200 feet and is somewhat brittle. This tree was started from seed six years ago by the homeowner's son.

2. Orange Crush Jackfruit, *Artocarpus heterophyllus*. The tree can reach heights of 80 feet. Fruit harvested from late Spring to Fall. Fruits grow on the trunk and branches, enhancing their attractiveness. Fruits can weigh up to thirty pounds.

3. Variegated Madagascar Jasmine Vine, *Stephanotis floribunda 'Variegata'*. Produces fragrant white flowers along with its variegated leaves. Makes a great house plant or outdoors on a trellis. Likes bright, indirect light and well-drained soil.

4. Silk Floss Tree, *Ceiba speciosa*. A statement tree with unique spiny thorns on its trunk and branches. A deciduous tree, but produces beautiful pink or lavender flowers towards Fall. The floss from the tree was used for stuffing pillows and life jackets.

5. *Philodendron 'Jose Buono'*. Eye-catching plant with large striking leaves of deep green, and splashes of yellow. Easy to care for and can grow indoors or out. Prefers bright indirect light.



6. Ylang-ylang, 'Cananga odorata.' Known for its very fragrant, star-shaped flowers which are used to produce essential oil for perfumes (like Chanel No 5). It's evergreen, and blooms on and off throughout the year here. A quick grower which can reach 40 to 60 feet.

7. Wild Lime, *Zanthoxylum fagara*. A very spiny aromatic small tree. A member of the citrus family but not a true lime.

Provides food and cover for wildlife. A crucial larval host for butterflies, especially the giant swallowtail.

8. Dancing Bones, *Hatiora salicornioides*. A tropical epiphytic cactus with segmented, bottle-shaped stems that trail and produce small yellow-orange flowers. Grows well indoors or out, in indirect light. Does well in a hanging basket.

9. American Ocotillo, *Fouquieria splendens*. A striking spiny succulent known for its upright stems and small leaves. Full sun is required and can reach 20 feet.

10. Mona Lisa Lipstick, *Aeschynanthus radicans* 'Mona Lisa.' Known for its beautiful blooms and deep green leaves. A graceful, draping plant that can be grown indoors or out. Needs regular watering and abundant sunlight, but not full sun.





GARDEN 1 – Sound of Music

This peaceful garden will display vehicles provided by the wonderfully generous Treasure Coast Classic Chevy Club!

GARDEN 2 – 007

There will be a sleek display of 20 Corvettes ranging from 1959-2023. These include C1, C2 & C8 Corvettes. In the event of rain, these will be housed in a warehouse on the property and viewable to ticket holders. Be sure to see this fantastic array of vehicles!

GARDEN 3 – Indiana Jones

At this garden look for the 1967 Jeepster Commando convertible in Indian ceramic red that will remind you of vehicles driven in Indiana Jones. Just a piece of trivia, Lucille Ball once zipped around in a similar vehicle.

GARDEN 4 – Alice in Wonderland

This whimsical garden will have an equally whimsical group of cars including a 1940 Ford Coupe in sierra gold, a 1949 Pontiac Catalina convertible in creamy yellow with an interesting air filter design, a 1954 Nash Healey convertible in silver, an Excalibur which is a showy car modeled after elegant and prestigious cars of the 1920s and 1930s, and finally a 1927 Ford Track Roadster in blue. The owner of this vehicle holds 3 speed records (one is still standing) with another car. Don Bigelow raced the gasoline carburetor car on the Bonneville Salt Flats in Utah at 324mph. Make sure you talk to each of these owners!




