We are advised that most likely at the January 8<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting of the City Commission at 4 pm one of the proclamations will be presented.

On January 12<sup>th</sup> 250 South Florida Slash Pine seedlings will be picked up for distribution to the Boys & Girls Clubs – hopefully on Arbor Day in the afternoon (of January 19<sup>th</sup>).

Also, in relation to Arbor Day we are in conversation with James Eberhardt, Superintendent of Martin County's Parks and Recreation regarding the planting of a native tree at 11:00 am on January 19th - most likely at a suitable location within Halpatiokee Park.

Finally, and before the November deadline, the Garden Club of Stuart has submitted FFGC Award Applications for 10 awards, 3 of which were flower show related. Award winners will be announced at the FFGC Convention in April.
