Memory Lane Report

During Hurricane Ian a large mango tree on the Audubon portion of the Possum Long Nature Center was compromised and Audubon had to take it down.

Also, the storm snapped off a massive portion of a very tall pine tree just south of our Memory Lane Gardens and threw into one of the tall mango trees above the Satin Leaf Circle's Garden where it got hung up and was not noticed until recently. Since the big piece of trunk hanging there about 15-20' above ground is potentially dangerous, this chairman has put up caution tape across the access paths to this area. Meanwhile Audubon has been notified and will address the problem. However, they have asked if the garden club could assist with some financial help. Audubon is seeking an estimate or estimates to remove the hanging piece. At present there is a balance of \$200 in the Civic budget available for Memory Lane.
