Memory Lane Annual Report

- During the summer of 2021 Audubon of Martin County had the Possum Long House removed. The newly vacant area where the house stood has been levelled, covered with pine needle mulch and two picnic tables added.
- Audubon has plans for a “picnic pavilion” to be constructed where the Possum Long house stood.
- The electricity to the well pump has been reconnected with a lock on the on/off switch. This chairman will have a key to the lock.
- The memorial plaques honoring deceased members have been reinstalled on the newly erected water pump enclosure wall.
- The garden verse sign within the Hibiscus Circle’s garden has been refurbished by Marty Neal and her husband.
- Audubon is in the process of installing new more prominent signage at the entrance to Memory Lane to read:
